

SNOWFLAKE PRINCESS



Welcome to the 8th Annual **Kappa Delta Phi Sorority Snowflake Princess Contest**. For more than 80 years Gamma Mu has been a strong philanthropic presence in the local community with our motto being “Kids Depend Upon People”. We are a Nationally recognized 501c non-profit organization and monies raised are used to assist those in need within Boone County.

“Philanthropic” is defined as seeking to promote the welfare of others, especially by donating money to good causes; generous and benevolent. The purpose of the Snowflake princess contest is to promote this sense of giving at an early age.

To be eligible, participants must be female and in grades 2nd thru 5th and live in Boone County. The contest is open to 20 girls who complete an application between today and November 4th. (Applications are below and will also be available at the park on Nov. 4th at 11:45am.) Please bring the completed application to Lebanon Memorial Park on Saturday, November 4th at noon to the large shelter house by the War Memorial. If there are more than 20 girls who complete an application there will be drawing of names at noon. Collection cans will be handed out to the 20 girls selected to participate. Due to busy schedules the contestant does not need to be present, but someone must come to turn in the application and receive collection cans in her place.

If selected to participate each girl will be assigned a number and receive two donation cans. (additional cans available upon request-email or call Suzi Boyett) Please remember that number and decorate the cans making sure to include her number and name (if you choose) along with her charity of choice on the cans. She is then asked to collect money (no checks please) from family, friends etc. She could ask to have her can placed at a local establishment for random donations; she could market her cause on social media; she could go door to door. It is her choice on how to raise awareness and money. On Monday, November 27, 2023, by close of business, all princess candidates will bring all cans to The Farmers Bank, 2304 N. Lebanon Street. The cans will be emptied, monies counted and deposited by bank employees. Totals will be listed by candidate number only. If you are unable to bring donation cans to The Farmers Bank that day, you must call or email Suzi Boyett (765)336-1042 or email suziandernie@msn.com.

The candidate must be available on Saturday, December 2nd, 2023, at 4:00 pm for the coronation at the Courthouse -It will be indoors in the center Rotunda area. Each candidate will be given the opportunity to walk to the front of the stage area as her bio is read. After each has had a turn, the contestant who raised the most money will be crowned – Boone County 2023 Snowflake Princess. Thirty percent of each contestant’s earnings will be donated by check from Kappa Delta Phi to her chosen charity – the remaining funds are a donation to Gamma Mu to continue our efforts within the community. If, for any reason, you received your cans and you decide not to participate, please email us and return your cans in a timely manner. There may be other girls that would like to participate. If you do not fill both cans, you are still required to return both to the bank.

We will also be participating with a float for the Snowflake Princess and ALL candidates in the Holiday Lights Parade. Every girl who participates can ride on the float. This event takes place Saturday evening, December 2nd, beginning at dusk (approximately 6 pm but arrive no later than 5:45 please) and goes from the Lebanon Memorial Park to the Courthouse Rotunda. All contestants are encouraged to participate in this as well. Holiday dress such as Santa hats, elf hats, muffs, etc. are encouraged. Please take the weather into account and dress accordingly.

A liability/consent form must be signed and on file to participate in the parade.
